

✓ Rehabilitation and gentle exercise


Physiotherapy, including exercises designed around your daily living/personal care tasks, to promote or maintain independence; pain management and motivation.

We can take you out into the community, accompanying you to appointments, social events and trips out. We can also help with correspondence and setting up appointments.


✓ Companionship
